

RESOLUTION NO. R-17-06

**APPROVING ANTELOPE ALLEY WATERMASTER
NEW OR REPLACEMENT WELL APPLICATION FOR EXISTING
PRODUCTION RIGHTS AND FEE**

WHEREAS, the Antelope Valley Watermaster, formed by the Antelope Valley Groundwater Cases Final Judgment (Judgment) Santa Clara Case No. 1-05-CV-049053 signed December 23, 2015; and

WHEREAS, said Judgment provides for the Formation of a Watermaster to administer the judgment; and

WHEREAS, said Judgment provides that the Watermaster Engineer shall prepare and adopt Rules and Regulations for conduct pursuant to the Judgment; and

WHEREAS, the Rules and Regulations shall include a New or Replacement Well Application for Existing Production Rights (Application); and

WHEREAS, a Fee of \$50 to cover the review of the Application based on an estimated collective time of 15 to 30 minutes at a rate of \$100 to \$200 per hour; and


WHEREAS, the review of the Application includes activities such as;

- review of the form for legibility and completeness,
- identification of the new or replacement well location (and old well if applicable),
- use of well (e.g., domestic, agricultural, public supply, monitoring)
- determination that wells are in the Adjudication Area (checked by APN parcel number in the Project Geographical Information System (GIS) by Todd Groundwater.
- estimation of target aquifer and area/subarea of production
- changes to current production, as applicable, and
- recordation of information in project database.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Watermaster Board unanimously approved the New or Replacement Well Application for Existing Production Rights and Fee.
